The Bud Griswold Memorial Scholarship provides an award to individuals focusing on natural resource/environmental conservation. The 2025 Scholarship will be \$500.00.

To be eligible, the recipient must be enrolled in a two- or four-year accredited college or university in a degree program relating to fisheries, aquatic sciences, natural resource management, environmental sciences, or related fields. Preference will be given to students pursuing graduate degrees.

Qualified recipients will have a proven track record of community service throughout previous years of study.
