Marge Moyers Memorial Scholarship Eligibility

This scholarship was established to honor New Market resident and Shenandoah County retired teacher Marge Moyers by providing financial support to students who may need a helping hand to accomplish their educational goals.

We are delighted that you are interested in applying for the Marge Moyers Memorial Scholarship. The Scholarship Fund was established in 2003, to benefit students in Shenandoah County. The award includes a scholarship gift for the benefit of the recipient furthering his or her education and totals \$8,000, payable over four consecutive years to the school the winner attends. A scholarship committee determines the recipient from the information provided on the attached application form and from a personal interview of the applicant. Please print neatly or type the application, and feel free to add pages whenever necessary in answering questions. Please make sure the application is printed only on one side.

Eligibility for Scholarship:

- Desire to go into education
- Any Shenandoah County high school Senior
- Must graduate from high school with current seniors
- Must enroll in the fall semester/quarter following graduation from high school in a school that meets IRS tax-exempt status
- Application must be typed or printed legibly in black or blue ink
- Must be willing to meet virtually with the committee for an interview if chosen as a finalist

Conditions of Scholarship:

- All disbursements will be made directly to the school where the student is enrolled for no more than four scholarship years. (Students may request payment on a semester or annual basis.)
- Each recipient is responsible for providing the Foundation with documentation of enrollment for each payment period, accompanied by grades from the institution, so that proper disbursement may be made.

- Funds must be issued for tuition, room and board, and university fees.
- Shenandoah Community Foundation must be notified if change occurs in the student's school standing and must receive Foundation approval as a condition of the continued disbursements.
- Enrollment in a non-tuition school requires notification to the Foundation and will result in forfeiture of the benefits of the scholarship.
- Any recipient found guilty of a criminal act will forfeit any remaining disbursements.

Candidate evaluation will be based on the following:

- Candidate's academic achievement (GPA and standardized test scores)
- Candidate's citizenship and character
- Essay to Scholarship Committee

The total amount of the scholarship to be awarded in 2025 will be **\$8,000**.
